

Tilburg Lacrosse Cup Terms and Conditions

1. Agreement with Terms and Conditions of Registration

In completing your registration for, and/or by attending the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup, you agree to the Terms and Conditions of registration and participation. If you are an individual registering a team, it is your responsibility to ensure that each of your coaches, players, and anyone else associated with the team attending the event are aware of, and abide by these Terms and Conditions, to include the rules and regulations governing play, tournament and community facilities, and participant behavior, both on and off the field. Violation of the aforementioned regulations may result in the disqualification of your team and/or player(s) and removal from the premises of Were Di Tilburg.

2. Registration

The only way to secure your team's placement in the tournament is to complete the online registration process and submit payment. If all available spots are filled, teams will be placed on a waitlist and accepted into the tournament if spots become available.

- 2.1. Signing up for the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup is done by sending an email to info@tilburglacrossecup.nl that includes the following details: the team name, whether it's a men's or women's team, the expected amount of players and the contact person. This has to be done within a month of receiving the email with the invitation.
- 2.2. After signing up, the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup organization (hereafter: TLC) selects the teams that can participate in the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup. The selected teams will be notified before 21st of march.
- 2.3. Within two weeks of being notified of their selection, teams must provide TLC with a full list of all participants' names, jersey number and dietary restrictions.
- 2.4. After registering, extra players can only be registered through sending an email to info@tilburglacrossecup.nl, with the name of the team, and the information as required by article 2.3.
- 2.5. All participants must be 16 years or older.
- 2.6. A team need to consist of at least 13 persons.
- 2.7. Subscription to the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup is official when the contact person, aside from the application by email, has paid the required fees as detailed in article 3
- 2.8. TLC will confirm all complete registrations.

3. Tournament Fees

Payment terms are as follows:

- 3.1. Each team is required to pay the team fee for the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup. The team fee covers up to 15 participants. Teams will be charged an additional player fee for every

extra participant.

- 3.2. The team fee for the 2022 edition of the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup has been set at €900 (nine-hundred euros). The player fee for the 2022 edition of the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup has been set at €60 (sixty euros).
- 3.3. Payment is due within two weeks after receiving the invoice from the organization.
- 3.4. Should a team decide to pull out of the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup more than four weeks before the tournament date, they are allowed to find a replacement team. Upon finding a replacement, the team will receive their payment back in full. Should the team fail to find a replacement, only 1/3rd of the tournament fees will be refunded.
- 3.5. TLC will not refund any payments if a team or player pulls out within four weeks of the start of the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup.
- 3.6. Should TLC voluntarily decide to cancel the event, all tournament payments will be refunded in full.
- 3.7. Should the event be cancelled due to circumstances beyond the reasonable control of TLC, such as a natural disaster or national/local/public state of emergency, tournament fees may be retained by TLC.
- 3.8. Food and drinks can only be bought with Were-Di tokens, for sale on location at the event. These tokens cannot be sold back to TLC.

4. Entry to the Tournament

- 4.1. Teams that do not meet the terms and conditions will be denied entry to the event location and cannot participate in the tournament.
- 4.2. Participants will be required to sign their name on their team's roster upon arrival, thereby agreeing with the Liability Waiver, specified in article 7.
- 4.3. Upon entry participations must show identification to prove that they are above 16 years old. Participants who cannot show valid identification may not participate in the tournament.
- 4.4. Everybody will receive a bracelet to show that they are participants of this tournament. These bracelets will only be given to registered participants. When the bracelet is lost a new one can be provided by the organization for a small fee.

5. Code of Conduct

- 5.1. Participants of the Tilburg Lacrosse cup are required to show their identification at any given moment if asked by TLC staff.

- 5.2. Participants are required to wear their Tilburg Lacrosse Cup bracelet during the tournament. Only people with a valid bracelet will be allowed on the property of Were Di Tilburg
- 5.3. It is strictly forbidden to smoke or bring glass objects onto the fields of Were Di Tilburg.
- 5.4. Damaging the building of Were Di Tilburg, or any of the fields is strictly forbidden.
- 5.5. The use, possession and/or distribution of illicit substances (this includes marijuana) is forbidden on the property of Were Di Tilburg.
- 5.6. The use, possession and/or distribution of any type of weapon is forbidden on the property of Were Di Tilburg.
- 5.7. Open fires and barbecues are forbidden. On the property there will be fire-extinguishers, only to be used in case of fire. Abuse of the fire-extinguishers is forbidden. Violators will be held liable for any type of damages relating to the usage of the fire-extinguisher.
- 5.8. It is not allowed to bring any type of alcohol to the event.
- 5.9. Alcohol is only sold to persons who are 18 years or older, a valid ID may be asked when purchasing alcohol.
- 5.10. The usage of personal stereo equipment is not allowed on the property of Were Di Tilburg.
- 5.11. Cars must stay outside of the fence and can be placed on the parking lot of H.C. Were Di. Were Di Tilburg and TLC are not responsible or liable for any damages to cars, whether they were parked in the parking lot or on the street.
- 5.12. Caravans, campers and/or trucks are not allowed on the property of Were Di Tilburg. They cannot be placed on the parking lot. Camping is only permitted in tents, which may be placed on the property of Were Di Tilburg.
- 5.13. Bikes may only be placed in the designated spots. This is to enable unobstructed passage for emergency services.
- 5.14. The house rules of Were Di Tilburg must be respected.

6. Lacrosse Rules

- 6.1. Games will be played in accordance with the international rules for lacrosse, as determined by World Lacrosse. For more information, see:

- 6.2. Games will be played on artificial field hockey turf.

- 6.3. During tournament games female players are required to wear a proper fitting mouthguard, team jersey with a number on the front and back, and proper shoes. TLC also recommends wearing proper fitting lacrosse goggles.
- 6.4. During the games of Tilburg Lacrosse Cup male players are required to wear a proper fitting mouthguard, gloves, helmet, team jersey with a number on the front and back, and proper shoes.
- 6.5. In the event the score is tied at the end of a game, the game will be decided by 'Braveheart', due to time constraints. This rule does not apply to final placement games, which will be in regular overtime.

7. Tilburg Lacrosse Cup Participant Waiver & Release of Liability

I am choosing to participate in the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup. I understand that lacrosse is a strenuous, fast-paced game involving physical contact with inherent dangers, and when played within the bounds of the rules, can result in serious injury, paralysis and even death. I assume all the risks of such injury and even death, inherent in the game of lacrosse. I will inspect the fields that I will play, coach, work, and/or spectate on, and confirm them to be in such a condition that there are no dangers visible to me; if I do see dangerous conditions on the field, I will notify TLC staff immediately.

I acknowledge and recognize that TLC, the entity that organizes the event, does not and cannot control the conduct of players and that their conduct is controlled to the extent of the rules of the game by the discretionary calls of lacrosse officials. I also acknowledge that there are dangers inherent in spectating and being present at the event site. Lacrosse balls can travel at speeds in excess of 100 mph and cannot be confined to the fields. I assume the risk of injury from being struck by lacrosse balls. I also understand that players do not and sometimes cannot stop running or avoid being pushed outside of the lines of the field of play. I have been told and I recognize that it is dangerous to sit or stand within five (5) yards of the sideline of any field and in areas designated and marked as off limits. I agree not to sit or stand within five (5) yards of the sideline of any field or in any areas designated and marked as off limits except when I am playing or preparing to play. While spectating, I agree not to sit or stand within five (5) yards of the sideline of any field or area designated or marked as off limits.

I represent that I am outfitted with equipment that meets meets specifications relevant to play, i.e., helmet, gloves, arm pads, goggles. I am aware that there are greater dangers if I do not use such equipment, and I assume all associated risk.

TLC makes every effort, both in preparation and on-site, to consider the general safety of event venues and its attendees. There are inherent risks associated with attending a sporting event; attendees (to include spectators) agree to be present and spectate at their own risk.

I agree to advise any family member or guest who accompanies me to the event about the dangers of spectating or being present on the grounds and that it is important that they be extra vigilant about the above dangers and take precaution. I recognize that the event organizers will rely upon my agreement to do so.

I further understand that it is recommended that I consult with a physician prior to participating in physical activity such as lacrosse. I do hereby declare myself to be physically sound and suffering

from no condition, impairment, disease, infirmity, or other illness that would prevent or impair my participation in any of the activities of the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup. I do hereby acknowledge that I have been informed that a physician's approval prior to my voluntary participation in the event is recommended. I acknowledge that I have either had a physical examination and have been given my physician's permission to participate, or that I have decided to participate without the approval of my physician, and do hereby assume all responsibility for my actions and physical conditions arising from any participation in the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup. I acknowledge that TLC reserves the right to deny participation if it is deemed by the medical staff that my participation could cause further harm to myself, or to others.

TLC makes every effort to facilitate and promote fair and safe competition. Burden is on the player, guardian, and coach to be aware of and in compliance with published terms and conditions, and eligibility guidelines/restrictions. TLC is not responsible for, but reserves the right to disqualify any team and/or player who is determined ineligible.

I assume all risks and on behalf of myself and my heirs and assigns waive, release and forever discharge the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup organization, Were Di Lacrosse, Were Di Tilburg and its officers, employees, contractors, affiliates, sponsors, volunteers, representatives, Event Venues, and all others associated therewith from any and all responsibilities or liability for injuries or damages resulting from my participation in and/or attendance at the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup, including, but not limited to, the games, my preparation for the games, spectating, staff duties/activities, being present at any meetings and social events, and agree not to sue them.

I agree to indemnify and defend the releasees and hold them harmless from any and all claims, suits, causes of action and damages of any kind caused by, or resulting or arising from, my participation in or attendance at the event, including, but not limited to, damages to the property of, or injury or death to, the releasees, the undersigned or anyone else.

I hereby give my consent to the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup organization to provide, through a medical staff of its choice, customary athletic training attention, as well as arranging for transportation to medical facilities/hospitals and/or emergency medical services as the medical staff deems warranted in the course of my participation in the SLV Event.

I have read and agree to all terms of the event, especially with regard to my responsibilities as a participant. My signature certifies that I understand and accept the conditions required for the Tilburg Lacrosse Cup.
